Attendance Matters

At Nottingham Girls' Academy we expect pupils to attend school for at least 97% of the time

1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons missed!


90% attendance over 5 years of secondary school = half a school year missed!

Research suggests that 17 missed school days a year = A drop in GCSE grades. This is anyone on 85%.



HOW MANY DAYS OFF WILL RESULT IN A PUPIL BECOMING PERSISTENTLY ABSENT?

Half-term 1	3 ½ days off school from September until October half-term holiday
Half-term 1-2	7 days off school from September until the Christmas holiday
Half term 1-3	10 days of absence from September until February half-term
Half term 1-4	12 ½ days of absence from September until the Easter holidays
Half-term 1-5	15 ½ days of absence from September until May half-term
Half-term 1-6	19 days of absence for the full academic year (September to end of summer term in July)

The link between excellent attendance and excellent progress/attainment in GCSE exams is astonishingly strong.

There is still huge room for improvement. In particular:

- Term time holidays There have been 71 holidays since September.
- 48 parents have been issued penalty notices for these.

• Medical/dental appointments - we expect that pupils attend as much of the day as is possible, and at least part of the afternoon or morning sessions.
